UTAH MINE SAFETY COMMISSION INVITES PUBLIC COMMENT  
AT MEETING TO BE HELD IN HUNTINGTON, UTAH

The Utah Mine Safety Commission will hold a meeting to receive public comment on Tuesday, September 25, 2007, in the gymnasium at the Huntington Elementary School, 70 East 100 North, in Huntington, Utah. The Commission will welcome public comment starting at 1:00 p.m. and throughout the afternoon. The Commission Meeting will begin at 10:00 a.m., when the Commission will hear from several scheduled presenters. This portion of the meeting will also be open to members of the public.

The Commission, created by Governor Jon Huntsman, Jr. in the wake of the Crandall Canyon mine disaster, has been charged with reviewing the role of the State of Utah in mine safety, accident prevention, and accident response, and to make recommendations regarding the State's role in these areas.

The public may provide comments either orally or in writing.
