UTAH MINE SAFETY COMMISSION TO MEET IN PRICE, UTAH -  
PUBLIC INVITED TO COMMENT

The Utah Mine Safety Commission will hold a meeting to receive public comment on Tuesday, October 2, 2007, at the College of Eastern Utah, Jennifer Leavitt Student Center Alumni Room, 451 East 400 North, Price, Utah, 84501. The Commission will welcome public comment starting at 1:00 p.m. and throughout the afternoon. The Commission Meeting will begin at 10:00 a.m. with a general business meeting. This portion of the meeting will also be open to members of the public.

Governor Jon Huntsman, Jr. created the commission in the wake of the Crandall Canyon Mine disaster to review the role of the State of Utah in mine safety, accident prevention, and accident response, and to make recommendations regarding the State's role in these areas.
